### PARK CONDITIONS & SAFETY RISKS FOR STARGAZING

- Park rules must be followed at all times.
- **This stargazing permit is not a waiver of parking fees.**
- A parking fee of \$5, an annual or 2-year pass, or a camping receipt is required to be posted in vehicle.
- This stargazing permit must be signed and posted in the vehicle along with parking fee receipt.
- The use of this stargazing permit is allowed only in the designated day-use areas.
- This permit is good only for the above named state park.
- This permit is good for the individual named above and one vehicle. Any type of event or activity scheduled for a group will be approved by the park manager.
- Overnight camping within day-use areas for stargazing activities is not allowed without special permission by park manager.
- Stargazing activities may be prohibited during special events. Check with website for event schedules.
- Restrooms may be locked at the day-use area. Campground restrooms are open 24 hours.
- Please follow best practices to avoid potential hazards that come with impaired night vision during nighttime activities – such as tripping hazards such as shrubs, trees, picnic tables, car stops, curbs, etc.
